Well, some beagles bark.

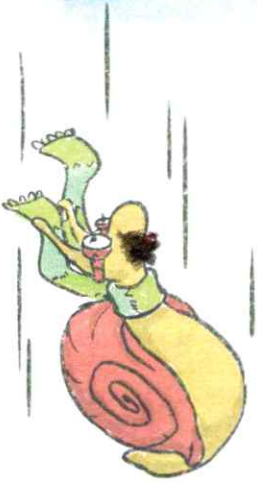
Oh, I know his name.
