Definitions of the Parts of Speech

noun: the name of a person, place, or thing

pronoun: a word that takes the place of a noun

adjective: a word that modifies a noun or pronoun

verb: a word that shows action or being or that links a subject to a subject complement

adverb: a word that modifies a verb, adjective, or another adverb

conjunction: a word that joins two words or two groups of words

preposition: a word that shows a relationship between its object and another word in the sentence

interjection: a word that shows emotion but has no grammatical function

Definitions of the Parts of the Sentence

subject: the noun or pronoun that the sentence is about

action verb: a verb that shows the subject acting

direct object: the noun or pronoun that receives the action of an action verb

linking verb: a verb that links two things together and says they are one

subject complement: a noun, pronoun, or adjective that is linked to the subject by a linking verb
