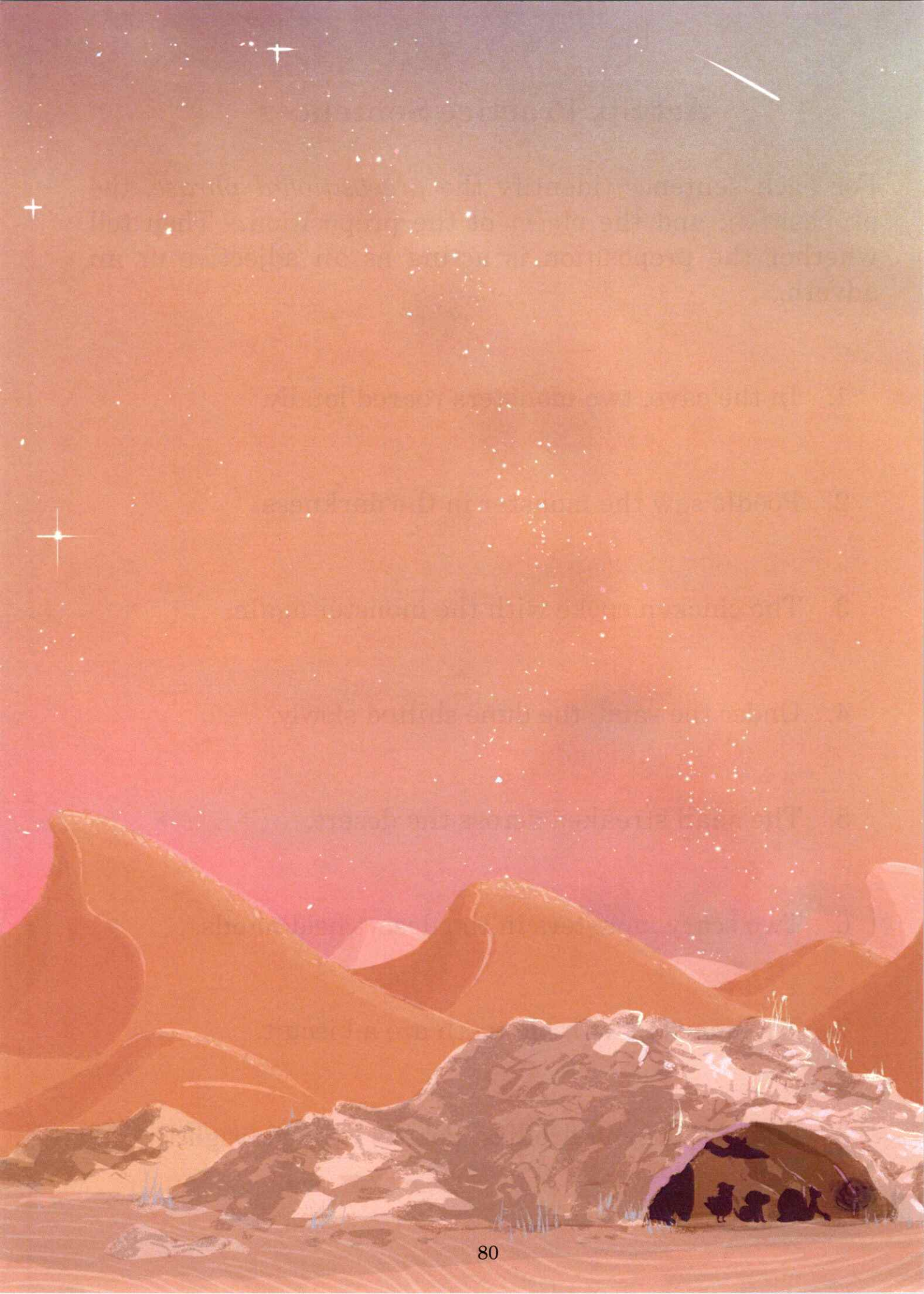


Act Six Practice Sentences
