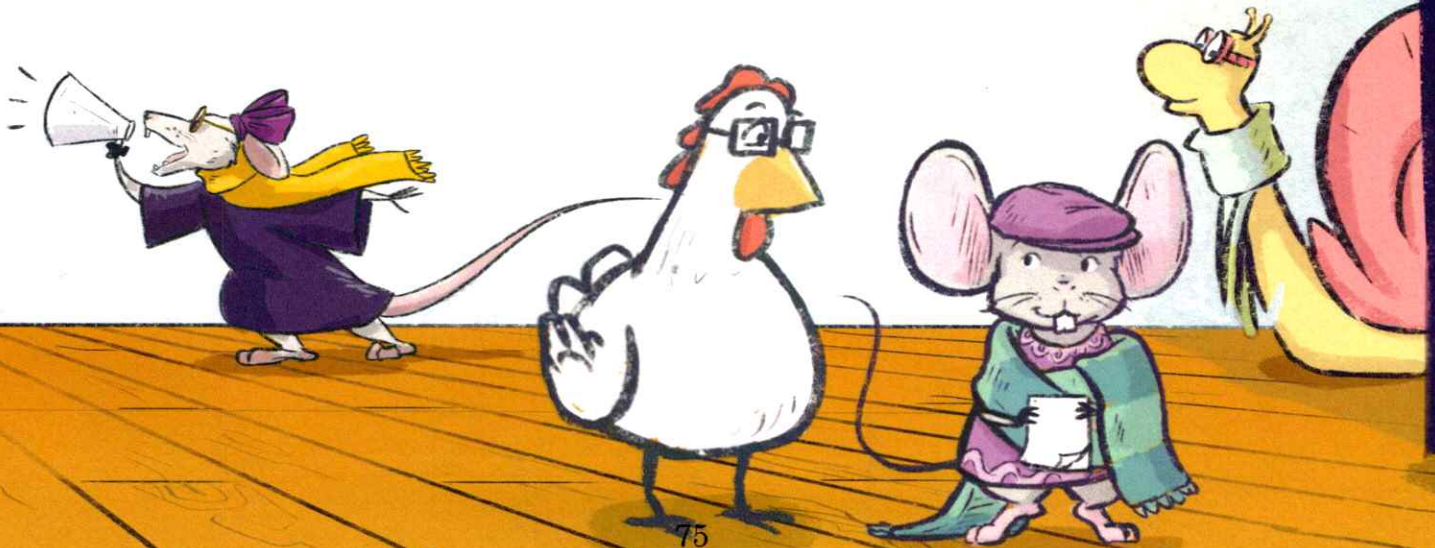
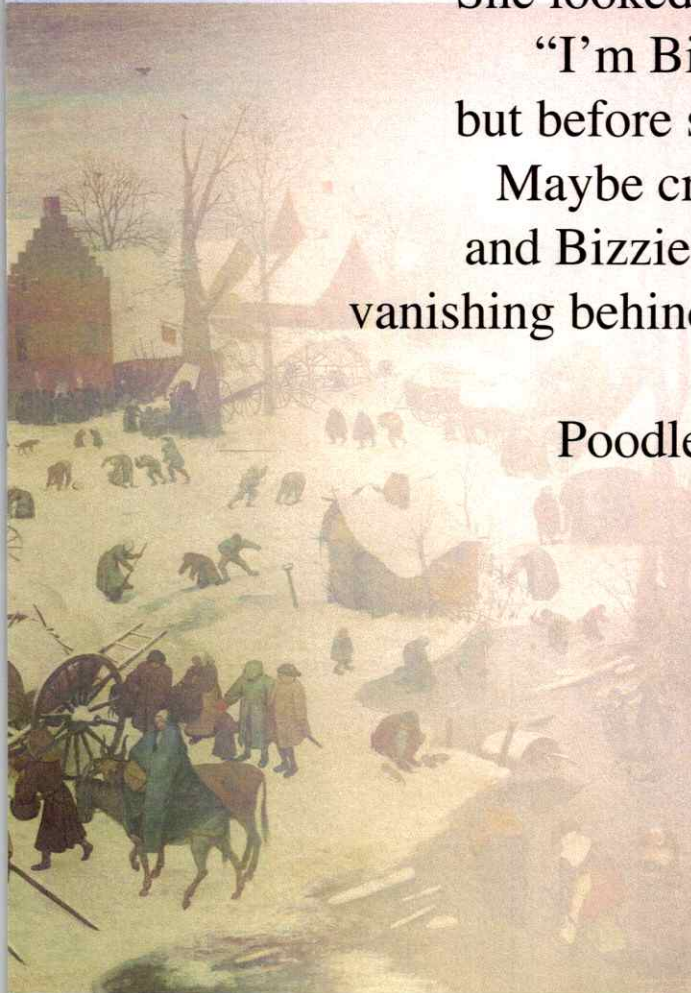


Poodle snuck a look at Bizzie.
