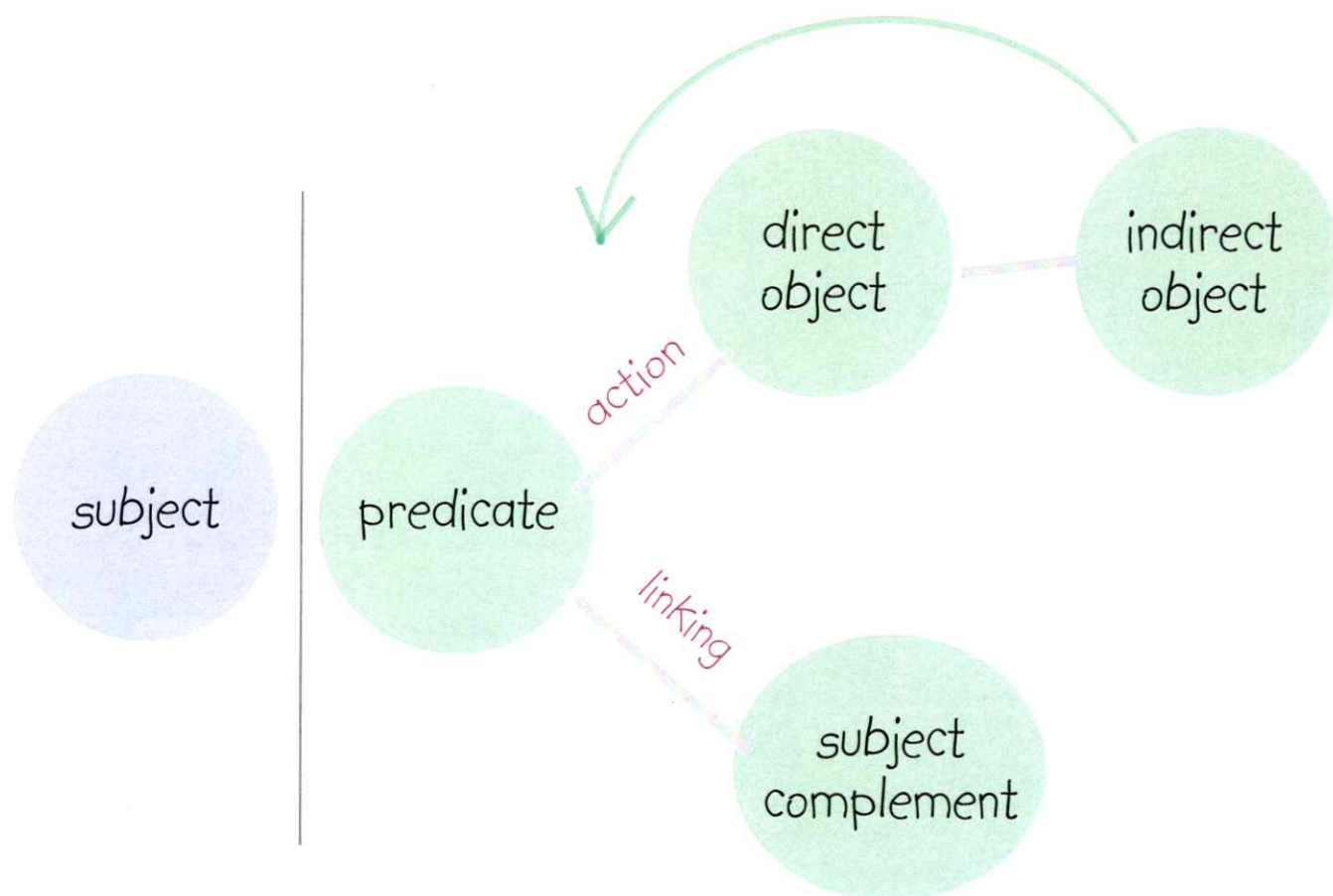
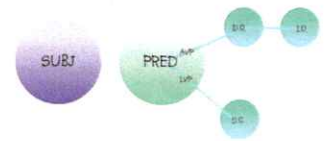


Based on the **VERB**, we have great names for the different parts of the sentence.
