

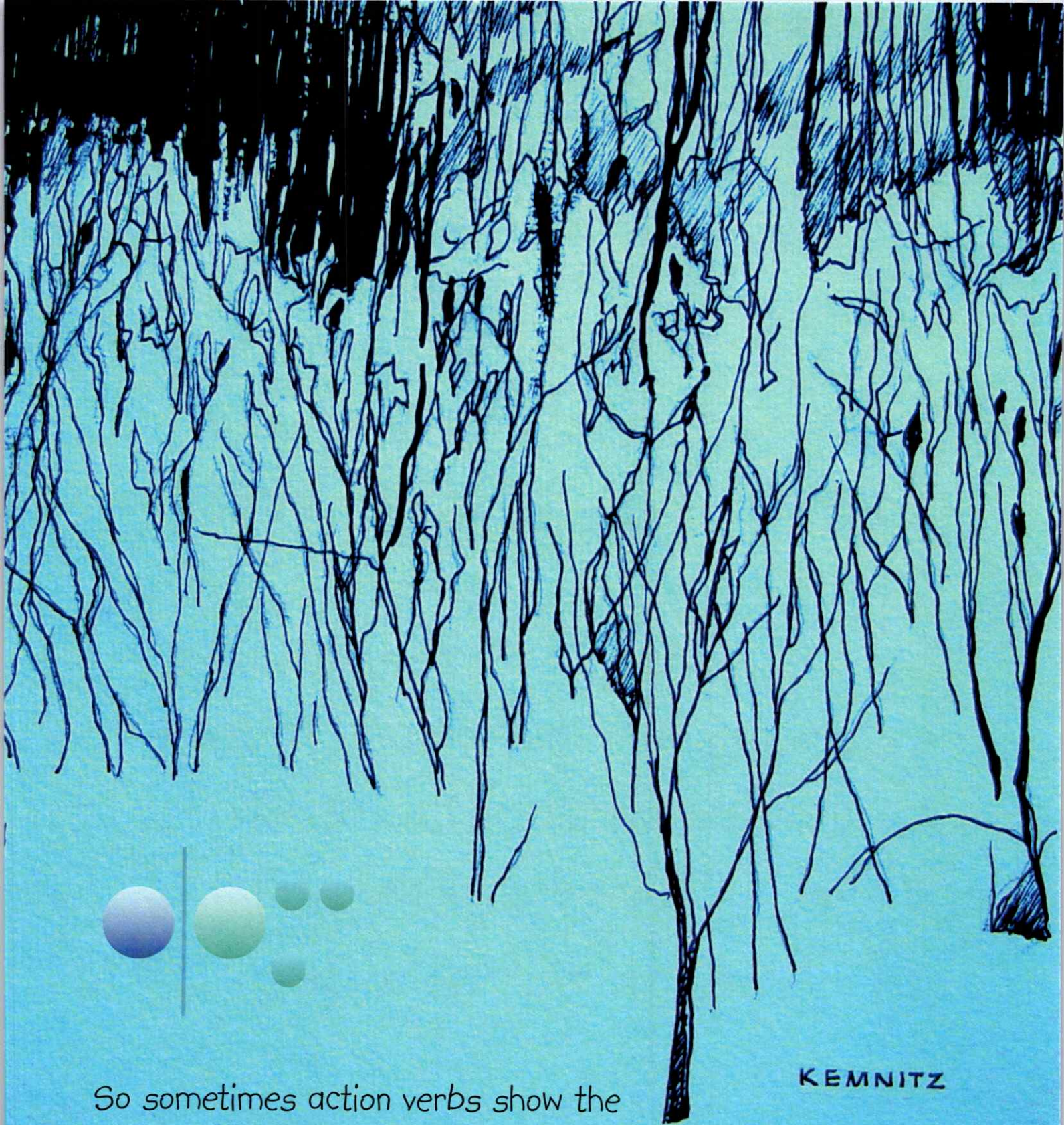
You try these sentences:
