1. Eleven fish swam in the blue lagoon.

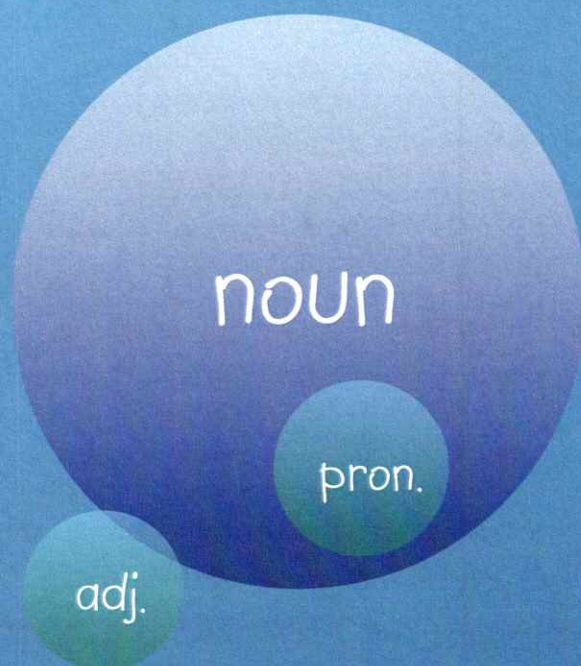
2. A friendly turtle ate little minnows.

and adjectives modify nouns or pronouns!

The pronoun is shown inside the noun because it is just another way of indicating the noun, but the adjective can modify either one equally.
