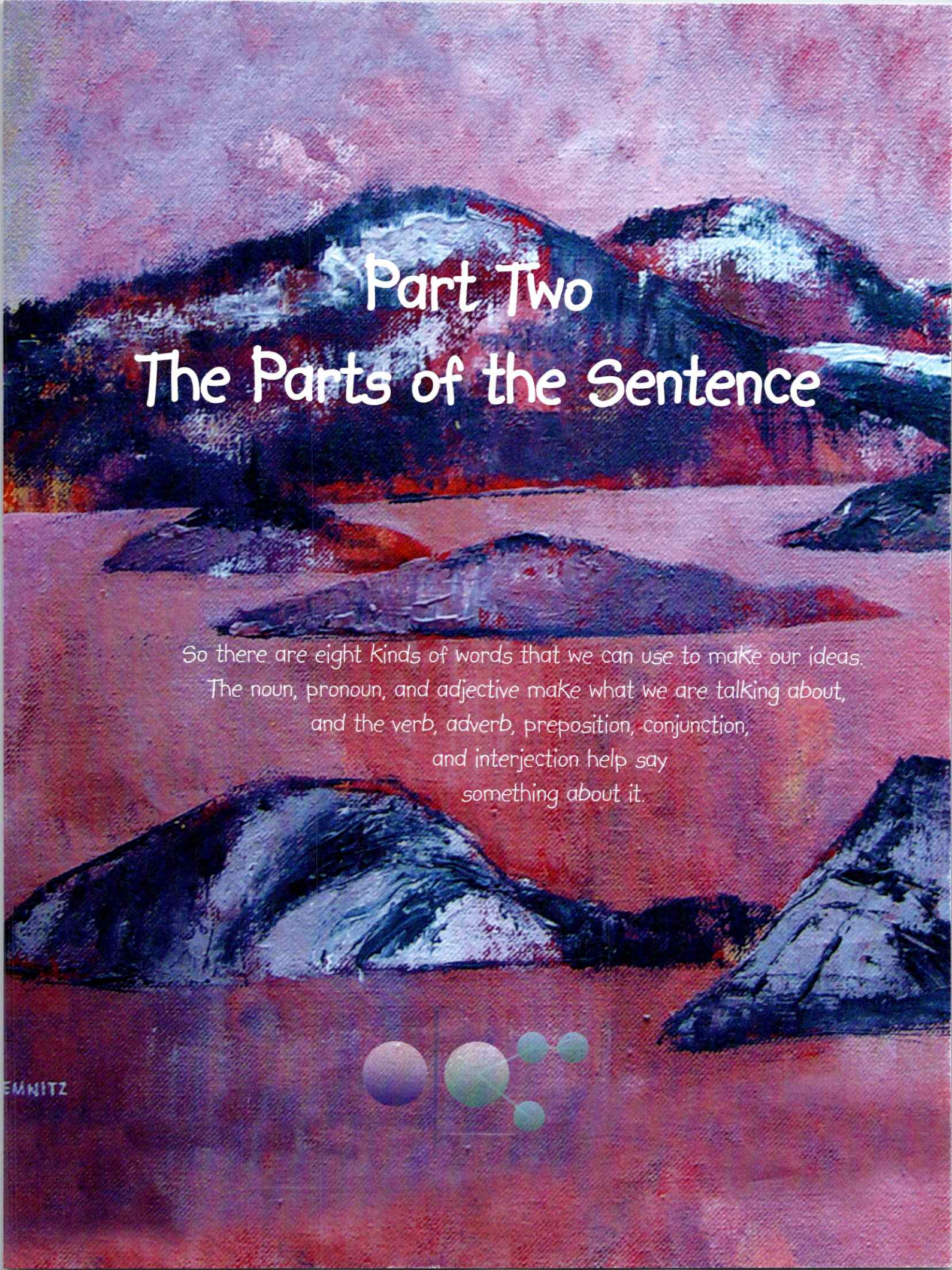


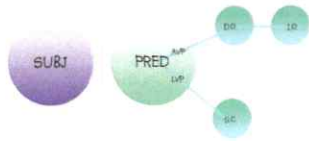


Part Two

The Parts of the Sentence

So there are eight kinds of words that we can use to make our ideas.
The noun, pronoun, and adjective make what we are talking about,
and the verb, adverb, preposition, conjunction,
and interjection help say
something about it.





In grammar, this whole idea
is called a SENTENCE.

Every sentence has TWO PARTS:

what it is about,
called the SUBJECT,
and

what we say about the subject,
called the PREDICATE.
