



LINKING VERBS

Not all verbs are action verbs.

Some verbs are
LINKING verbs.

A linking verb is like IS.
It says the subject IS something.

The old truck IS a jalopy.

IS links *truck* to *jalopy*. See?

With a linking verb, the subject is not
doing something to something *else*.
Now the subject IS the other thing.
