



One-Level Analysis for Level Two Sessions

You now will begin to study Level Two, **parts of sentence**. You will find that it does not take long to learn the parts of sentence. There are only five, and each one is an easy, clear concept. As you study Level Two, you should do one-level analysis every day to maintain and strengthen your command of Level One.
