



Two-Level Analysis for Level Three Sessions

You now will begin to study Level Three, **phrases**. There are only five kinds of phrases to learn: prepositional phrases, appositive phrases, and three kinds of verbal phrases. As you study Level Three, you should continue to do some two-level analysis every day so that you maintain and strengthen your command of Levels One and Two. Here are some two-level practice sentences that you can do during the Level Three instruction.

2. The celebrated painter is now the leader of the artists.

3. The unconventional painter has a new shipment of paint.

4. A group of furious warriors runs toward the forest.

5. My eyes fell upon the rusted sword, but it was not mine.

6. All Roman citizens had their own form of denial.

7. If the Visigoths attack before sunrise, we will seek shelter below.
